



General Information

Wyższa Szkoła Biznesu - National-Louis University (Nowy Sącz School of Business - National-Louis University) in Nowy Sącz, Poland is a non-public institution of higher education established in 1992. It is authorized by the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education to award the licentiate and master's degrees (licencjat and magister) in Management and Marketing, and Political Science, licentiate degree (licencjat) in Management, Computer Science, Social Work, engineer's degree (inżynier) in Computer Science, and Chemical and Process Engineering, master's degree (magister) in Management, and Psychology. The regular length of licentiate programme at WSB-NLU is 3 years. The length of master's degree programme vary between 1,5 and 2 years. The length of a unitary master's degree programme in Management and Marketing, and Psychology vary between 4,5 and 5 years. The length of engineer's degree programme is 3,5 years.

Release of Information

A transcript is a confidential document and cannot be released to a third party without the written consent of the student. Transcripts are not official without the stamp of the School.

ECTS Credits

ECTS is based on the principle that 60 credits measure the workload of a student during one academic year. The student workload of a study programme in Europe amounts in most cases to around 1500-1800 hours per year and in those cases one credit stands for around 25 to 30 working hours. Student workload in ECTS consists of the time required to complete all planned learning activities such as attending lectures, seminars, independent and private study, preparation of projects and examinations.

Course Numbering System

The letters preceding the numbers indicate the department or subject area. The three numbers indicate the level and sequence of courses within the programme.
