Climate Change Economics Course

The CERGE-EI Foundation Distance Learning Program *Climate Change Economics* course consists of 27 academic hours of online, live-streamed intensive lectures, with a focus on student interaction throughout. To successfully pass the course, students are required to attend and actively participate in the lectures and exercise sessions, to complete two home assignments, and to pass four online quizzes and a comprehensive final exam. The total expected workload of the course is 125 hours.

This course aims to give a deeper theoretical insight into economic externalities, with a particular focus on global warming. It delves into various classical economic instruments, such as Pigovian taxes, cap-and-trade programs, subsidies, and mandates. In addition, the course offers an overview of the economics of new potential decarbonization technologies and discusses the most recent decarbonization developments.
